Emergency Care at Avets

Emergencies can happen any time, day or night. When your cat or dog has an emergency and your primary care veterinarian is unavailable, **Avets is available 24/7/365 for walk-in care.**

Your pet will be evaluated upon arrival. Patients are seen according to the severity of their condition, followed by order of arrival—like you would experience in a human ER.

24/7 Emergency*

Treatment of trauma, life-threatening illness, emergency surgery, ingestion of foreign bodies or toxins, or other urgent patient needs

Avian & Exotics

Appointments for emergent symptoms, soft tissue and orthopedic surgery, diagnostics (CT, endoscopy, ultrasound), preventative wellness and reproductive care

Critical Care

Blood transfusions, long-term mechanical ventilation, oxygen support, pain management

Diagnostic Imaging

CT, echocardiography, MRI, digital radiography, ultrasound

Extracorporeal Therapy

Treatment for acute kidney failure, for certain toxicoses/poisonings, and for immune-mediated conditions

Internal Medicine

Endoscopy: digestive, nasal, respiratory, lower urinary

Neurology & Neurosurgery

MRI, CT, spinal surgery, brain surgery, seizure management, treatment for paralysis and other nerve disorders

Physical Rehabilitation

Laser therapy, post-op and geriatric physical therapy, land treadmill, electrical stimulation

Radioactive Iodine Therapy (I-131)

Treatment for hyperthyroidism in cats

Surgery

Orthopedic, minimally invasive, and soft tissue surgery
